New Business:

- 1. Consumers Electric 30-year Franchise Ordinance presented.
- ✓ Salsbury/Kuziel II Motion to approve Consumers Electric 30-year Franchise Ordinance RC: Lewis: Yes, Barajas: Yes, Salsbury: Yes, Snyder: Yes, Kuziel II, Yes
- 2. Esch's Septic would like to invoice the township yearly instead of monthly at a discount. Cost would be \$3,500 for 1 regular unit for 12 months and 2 handicap units for 5 months.
- ✓ Barajas/Snyder Motion to approve Esch's Septic Invoice for \$3,500, 4/25-4/26.
- 3. Invoice for first half of the NEMCOG contract (HRI Project) has been received for \$24,000, Clerk Amanda Barajas seeking approval to pay. The first half of the grant has been received for \$25,000.

- 4. Deputy Treasurer Deb Dew to retire May 6th. Treasurer Kevin Salsbury will start new deputy Tammy Tropiano that week. Salsbury proposed paying the deputy treasurer a salary instead of hourly wage.
- ✓ Barajas/Salsbury Motion to approve \$2,000 salary a fiscal year for the Deputy Treasurer Position.
- 5. The Fire Department will be transitioning to Active 911 Pager Service in the coming month; the county will invoice us in July at \$15 per firemen per year.
- 6. Recap of the townships damage due to the recent ice storm.
- 7. Mural opportunity at Boney Park discussed, to be followed up on.
- 8. Stephen & Son's would like to do another boxed audit this year. After Board discussion the township will be requesting an in-person audit.
- 9. Amanda Barajas requested the township directly contribute \$4,000 to Steiner Museum instead of depositing into their account through the township like previous years. Amanda to provide more information for further discussion.
